

19/298	<p>PLANNING:</p> <p>EXTON 19/1372/FUL Construction of two storey extensions, single storey extension, modifications to existing and addition of new windows and construction of detached store. Little Silver Exton Exeter EX3 0PP. SUPPORT. AIF.</p> <p>WOODBURY 19/1356/FUL Change of use of land from agricultural to self-storage facility and retention of 113 units plus provision of additional 10 units (157 in total) Rydon Farm Rydon Lane Woodbury Exeter EX5 1LB. SUPPORT. But would recommend the following conditions: Screening on the eastern elevation in line with the hedge line. Planting to be subject to TPO. Signage and safety measures for the amenity trail that is used by pedestrians and cyclists. Safety measures implemented for vehicles both entering and exiting both the top junction and lower road. 19/299	<p>CHAIRMAN'S REPORT: <i>No comments were made.</i></p>
19/300	<p>PARISH COUNCILLORS' REPORTS:</p> <p>Cllr P Bricknell explained he had attended a recent meeting of the Exmouth Police Local Action Group. Overall crime is up half of one percent. There has however been an increase of break ins to sheds and outbuildings particularly in outlying villages.</p> <p>Cllr P Bricknell also attended the Greendale Liaison Committee noting Greendale has 98% occupancy with a waiting list. He understands Greendale have a £10,000 fund earmarked for community issues and WPC should investigate if and how applications can be made.</p>
19/301	<p>COUNTY COUNCILLORS' REPORTS</p> <p>Cty Cllr J Trail explained that Devon & Cornwall Fire & Rescue Service are consulting on changes to the fire and rescue service in Devon and Somerset. There are a series of walk-ins taking place and he urged participation from Cllrs.</p>
19/302	<p>DISTRICT COUNCILLORS' REPORTS</p> <p>Dst Cllr B Ingham expressed the need for EDDC to tackle its impending financial deficit – a £2.7m gap over a four year period. He is confident that progress will be made on this over the next 12 months.</p> <p>Dst Cllrs B Ingham stated he had concerns over aspects of the GESP in particular developments of garden villages such as West End. He favours expansion closer to Enterprise Zones.</p> <p>Cllr G Jung explained that EDDC investigations into zero carbon housing suggested the additional cost for a four bedroom build is c. £35k and c. £8k for a small house. He felt that this could be unappealing for developers.</p> <p>Cllr G Jung explained that DCC had objected to the route of the cycle path between Darts Farm and Killerton – alternative routes are now being considered.</p>

19/303	NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN: Cllr J Pyne explained that recent focus had been on businesses, farming, tourism and biodiversity. The current aim is to approve the final submission with WPC by mid-September with a view that the NP could be submitted to EDDC in October.
19/304	LOCAL BUS SERVICES: Cllr R Ball explained that the current bus routes are operated by Stage Coach under subsidy. He felt Stage Coach had been slow to respond to his initial enquiries. He felt the structure of the current timetable and routes mean the service is not well used. As such, this invites some further investigation with Stage Coach.

AIF. 19/1580/FUL Construction of first floor bedroom extension, ground floor bedroom replacement roof and rear ground floor dining room extension. The Old School Exmouth Road Exton Exeter EX3 0PQ. SUPPORT. AIF.</p> <p>WOODBURY 19/1792/FUL Raising of ridge to provide first floor accommodation and replacement roof covering Willowbank Parsonage Way Woodbury Exeter EX5 1HY. SUPPORT. Six for, four against, one abstention. 19/1756/TCA T1 - BEECH - Reduce back by approximately 2m, existing crown spread 4m. Maximum diameter cut 50mm. 1 Brookleigh Greenway Woodbury Exeter EX5 1LN. SUPPORT. AIF. 19/1694/TCA T1, Oak : reduce back to growing point, reduce remaining crown where overhanging garden by maximum 2m Ferrand 7 Broadmead Woodbury Exeter EX5 1HR. SUPPORT. AIF. 19/1594/FUL Replace flat roof with pitched roof on existing front extension. 8 Long Park Woodbury Exeter EX5 1JB. NOT SUPPORTED. Insufficient level of detail given the extent of the works described in the main application. More information required. Seven in favour, two abstentions, two against.</p>
19/315	MEETING SUSPENDED: A parishioner with an interest in 19/1594/FUL stated he had not had an opportunity to speak on this application in the public session. The meeting was suspended so that he could speak. He pointed out that many properties in proximity had pitched roofs and provided photographic evidence. Some of the work outlined in the application had no immediate plans to undertake but he was advised to include them in the application. Cllr G Jung felt the application lacked detail in certain respects in particular the extent of the proposed cladding.

There has never been a vehicular access to the front of this property. There has been a shared access to the rear. The proposed access point is on a stretch of the A376 with limited visibility being just on the rising towards Harefield Cross. Whilst the speed limit may be 40mph, it is thought that vehicle speeds are generally higher. It is felt that an accident at this point could cause a fatality. A vehicular access will spoil the setting of this building. AIF.</p> <p>19/1541/FUL External changes to a building granted prior approval under application 18/1104/PDP for the change of use from storage and distribution (class B8) to a use falling within class C3 (dwelling houses) and extension to provide a covered porch and cloakroom and retention of part of the building for a workshop associated with caravan storage business East Devon Caravan Storage Toby Lane Woodbury Salterton Exeter EX5 1QB. SUPPORT. Seven in favour, four abstentions.</p>
<p>19/317</p>	<p>DEVON & CORNWALL FIRE & RESCUE CONSULTATION: Cllr R Cullen provided copies of the consultation document to Cllrs. He drew Cllrs attention to the various options outlined noting that all options involved station closures. His main concerns were the loss of skilled firefighters, the risk of increased response times and the length time required to train crews to operate a roving fire engine. He was not in favour of station closures. Cllr Murrin felt that station closures were inevitable and it would not be helpful to resist every option. Cllr R Cullen agreed to draft a response on behalf of WPC for review.</p>
<p>19/318</p>	<p>TO CONSIDER A PROPOSAL BY BT OPENREACH & VODAFONE TO INSTALL 89 METRES OF DUCT ACROSS WOODBURY VILLAGE GREEN: The proposal was reviewed. Cllr Mrs C McGauley felt that the ducting should run alongside the Green’s path rather than diagonally across the Green. She also felt that the Way Leave payment was not high enough and should be linked to improvements to the Green such as refurbishing the railings. Clerk to respond to OpenReach.</p>

<p>19/320</p>	<p>TO CONSIDER A PROPOSAL TO FENCE OFF AN AREA OF WOODBURY CRICKET FIELD: Cllr G Jung provided an overview stating that it had the support of the Community Orchard, the Cricket Club and CDE. It would be well received by dog walkers. Cllr Mrs C McGauley stated that the Council would consider a formal proposal but any proposal would have to have considered the issue of how it is funded.</p>
