19/337	Public session A Parishioner spoke in favour of 19/9170 explaining that it was a large plot and the plans were for a modest, set back, chalet style property suitable for a retirement. It was outside the conservation area but within the development area of Woodbury.

19/339	DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST: <i>None.</i>
19/340	PLANNING: EXTON – <i>None.</i> WOODBURY – 19/1970/OUT Outline application for the construction of dwelling seeking consent for access (all other matters reserved) Meadowside Broadway Woodbury Exeter EX5 1NR. Support. Seven in favour, two abstentions. WOODBURY SALTERTON – 19/1904/FUL Proposed footpath/cycleway Greendale Business Park Sidmouth Road Woodbury Salterton. Support. AIF.
19/341	DEVON AIR AMBULANCE NIGHT LANDING SITE: It was noted that cost would be £5,929.16 plus VAT. Devon Air Ambulance is able to offer WPC a grant of £3,034.27 to cover the labour costs leaving £2,894.89 for the equipment costs which would need to be funded. Cllr Mrs C McGauley felt that crowdfunding was a suitable route to funding the remaining costs and offered £100, as a support in principle, from the Chairman’s allowance. It was noted that support from nearby residents and the WPCF would also be required.
19/342	COOMBE SOLAR FARM COMMUNITY BENEFIT FUND: Cllr Mrs C McGauley underlined the need to stick to the criteria whilst considering applications. It was agreed that a rigorous filter was required for consideration by the sub-committee for the Solar Fund - consisting of Cllrs S Andrews, Mrs C Bennett, P Bricknell and G Murrin.
